All Trailers take Orinda Exit/BEAR CREEK ROAD or PINOLE ROAD - Cell range spotty depending on providers please review or print out directions prior to starting.

From 680/24/Caldecott Tunnel – take the Orinda exit and turn north toward Orinda Village. Take a right onto Bear Creek Road and continue onto Pereira Road. 1050 Pereira Road will be the first turn on your left.

From 80 – take Pinole Valley Rd exit and head South.

Gambler's Choice - Entry \$50 (\$10 class fee, \$40 to cash jackpot)

Fences range in height from 2'3" - 3'3"

Make up your own course and jump for points! 55 seconds will be permitted on the clock for each round. Each jump is assigned points based on degree of difficulty. You can jump fences in any order and in any direction, if rails are standing, but can't jump any fence more than three times. Final scores are determined by adding the total points and subtracting any penalties. A rail down or refusal results in that fence's points being deducted from your total. Riders with the three highest point count will win a cash jackpot. 1st place is awarded 75% of the total, 2nd place is awarded 15% of the total and 3rd place is awarded 10% of the total.

Equitation Medal Class - Entry \$50

2', 2'6" and 3' divisions offered based on entries

To be shown over a course of not less than 8 hunter and jumper type fences at 2', 2'6" and 3' divisions based on entries. Course must include one test. Emphasis on correct position as defined in USEF rulebook. TEST WILL BE POSTED IN THE MORNING.

HIGH POINT AWARDS DIVISIONS
SHOW AND YEAR-END DIVISION HIGH POINT CRITERIA

DIVISIONS:

1. Aquamarine, Turquoise & Periwinkle
2. Teal, Cobalt & Azure
3. Sapphire & Midnight
4. Indigo & Royal
5. Navy & Sky

High Point Division Rating structure: 6 points for 1st; 4 points for 2nd, 3 points for 3rd, 2 points for 4th, and 1 point for 5th. With classes of 3 or less deduct two points for each placing. **Division highpoints will include points earned in the jumping and flat classes with 3 or more.**

Schedule: Ring 1 and Ring 2 both start at 9:00 AM. Arenas will be open for schooling, only for horses entered in show, between 7:30 – 8:30 am sharp. Arenas will be available for walking between 8:30 -9:00 am.

Food: Breakfast and lunch are served in the food booth. Snacks and drinks are available as well.

Attire: Proper show attire – **Equitation/Hunter** classes: coat, tall boots or paddock boots with straps, breeches, rat catchers; no running martingales; **Jumper classes:** polo shirts and breeches. **MUST wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets while mounted.** Helmets must be latched while mounted. This also applies to Halloween costume class if mounted.

Jumpers Classes judged on closest to optimum time 325mpm -Single round determines winner. No jump off.

All Classes: Dangerous riding or horses will be eliminated per the judge's discretion. No refunds given.

Scratches: No refunds given. Credit towards next show given before the close date. No refunds or credit given after close date. No excuses accepted. Show will be held rain or shine!
